October Outreach Partner: Waverly Elementary School: For over 20 years Waverly School (formerly Watterson-Lake School) has been St. Peter's "adopted" school. Waverly is a K-8 school located at W. 74th & Detroit. We have had a rich and varied history with the children and staff. We began by sending volunteer tutors to help bolster deficient reading skills and encourage love of reading, then moved on to providing clothing to the neediest children through the Share the Blessings Project. Parishioners have taught a manners program, sponsored a knitting club and offered individual talents in other ways. Our loose plate offerings have purchased cheerleading uniforms, supported an end-of year family carnival and more.

That's the history. Now, the present: Waverly is in the Gordon Square area that is undergoing a revival with new construction and renovations, yet many in the neighborhood and school are still very needy, financially and academically. Our tutoring and financial support both make a difference. The State mandated third grade initiative is still in place—students not reading up to grade level will be retained. Through tutoring on a one-to-one level, we have had and continue to have the hope that the love of Christ flows through us to those we help.
