**April Outreach Partner: St. Peter's Childcare Center:** The outreach focus for the month of April is our very own St. Peter's Child Care Center. The Center has been operating at St. James school during the reconstruction of the building for the past year and is excited to be moving back into the brand-new building. The Center is a non-profit child care center that provides high quality child care to a very diverse population. Over 15% of the families attending St. Peter's Child Care Center are receiving assistance from the local or state agencies.

The Child Care Center and the School Age Program at Horace Mann Elementary has maintained a five-star rating through the Step Up to Quality program. This is the highest rating that is attainable for a program. The Center has also been awarded a contract with Invest in Children as a Universal PreK Program (UPK). The UPK Program makes high quality early care and education accessible to families by providing funding to enhance the quality, as well as scholarship assistance to low- and moderate-income families. Both the Step Up to Quality and UPK Programs require the Center to operate at higher standards than a Program who is just licensed by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services.

In keeping with the service ministry that is a part of the St. Peter's culture, the Center is involved in several service projects. The students at the Center participate in monthly outreach projects aimed at improving their community. Some of the recipients of their efforts include Providence House, St. Jude's Children's Hospital, the Pajama Program and the Ronald McDonald House of Cleveland.

At this time your generous donations will be used to help the Center transition into their new space with updated materials and furnishings for the classrooms and continue to provide our children with special Music and Art classes.
