July Outreach Partner: Stone Soup: Food pantries, soup kitchens and other community-based organizations address the hunger issue by serving a variety of meals, providing nutrition, support, dignity, and a sense of community. These organizations, as well as their dedicated staff and volunteers, need help.

Caterers, vendors, restaurants and other organizations want to donate excess product but don't have the time, space, transportation or manpower. Produce companies, grocery stores and small farms may want to donate produce that's ugly or imperfect (and therefore, unsellable) but face the same challenges.

We provide a food recovery and delivery service connecting those with excess and those in need. We limit waste by delivering the right food to the right place at the right time.

- Offered 100+ hours of educational lectures, classes and interviews about food waste and nutrition.

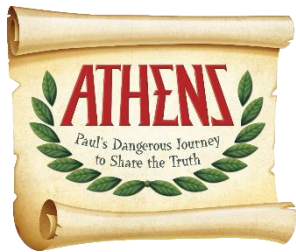

Fellowship after services will take place outdoors, weather permitting, on the plaza.



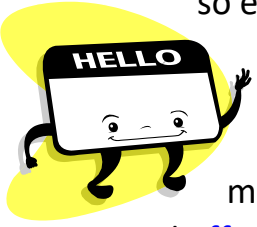
