August Outreach Partner: St. Luke's Episcopal Church: We are once again privileged to support the dedicated and energetic community of St. Luke's Episcopal Church on Cleveland's near west side. Located a few blocks away from Waverly Elementary School, it is in an area of great need. Our sister church is a firm rock in the Near West Side and Edgewater areas of Cleveland. "Your Neighbor's Cloak" is the name of their very popular thrift shop, where items are given to needy folks at no charge, and where the Food Bank distributes literally tons of food twice a month.

In August, there is a need for all kinds of school supplies from 24 count packs of crayons, colored paper and scissors to spiral notebooks, notebook paper and ballpoint pens. There is a continuing need for clean clothing of all types, including all sizes of socks and any-size new packs of children's underwear; small household and kitchen items, bric-a-brac and linens are also very desirable, as well as soap, tooth brushes, tooth paste, shampoo, lotion, paper goods. If you are downsizing your home, and have a lot of things, you can deliver them directly to St. Luke's – but be sure to call first to make sure someone is available to accept your delivery. The St. Luke's young people have painted murals on the outside of Your Neighbor's Cloak building which are worth seeing.
