They also appreciate the essentials such as toothpaste, extra food, and warm socks in the winter that we frequently provide. Finally, and perhaps most importantly, they come for the companionship. They sit with friends and talk about their day, the weather, and their hopes and concerns. We provide a safe and comfortable gathering spot for our greater community.

Community Meal benefits its volunteers as well! The kitchen is its own community of cooks, and all are welcome. Set-up volunteers transform the undercroft into a cozy dining room.
