Minor to Intermediate Home/Yard Repairs consist of:

- Caulking windows and doors
- Putting weather stripping around a door frame
- Unclogging a shower head
- Interior and Exterior Painting and Scraping
- Patching walls
- Drywall
- Cleaning gutters
- Replacing a toilet
- Foam a loose shower-head
- Re-grading around foundation
- Caulking around tubs, showers, etc.
- Adjusting and lubricating a window
- First/Single Story Roof replacement or repair
- Plumbing like replacing a fixture
- Deck repair
- Power Washing
- Fix a patchy lawn
- Mow Lawns
- Fertilize Lawns
- Spread Mulch
