Minor to Intermediate Home/Yard Repairs consist of:

- Caulking windows and doors
- Putting weather stripping around a door frame
- Unclogging a shower head
- Interior and Exterior Painting and Scraping
- Patching walls
- Drywall
- Cleaning gutters
- Replacing a toilet
- Foam a loose shower-head
- Re-grading around foundation
- Caulking around tubs, showers, etc.
- Adjusting and lubricating a window
- First/Single Story Roof replacement or repair
- Plumbing like replacing a fixture
- Deck repair
- Power Washing
- Fix a patchy lawn
- Mow Lawns

**Bike with the Bishop:** Join friends of all ages for a group ride departing from Bellwether Farm and arriving at St. Andrew's Episcopal Church in Elyria, where riders will enjoy a community lunch (20 miles). Cyclists will then reverse their route (for a total of 40 miles), or catch a ride in a vehicle heading back to Bellwether. A farm-to-table dinner will be served after the ride. Riders are encouraged to arrive at Bellwether Friday, **June 4** for dinner, a bonfire, and overnight rest before breakfast and the ride on Saturday. Prayer and departure will be at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, **June 5**. Cyclists are expected to provide their own bike and helmet. Support and Gear (SAG) vehicles will be on call in case of emergency, and water stops are provided along the route. Registration is open until June 1.
