- This will be a Drive-Thru/Walk-Up Vaccine Clinic. If you drive, you will not have to leave your vehicle. If you are walking, seating will be available if you need to wait your turn.
- Your vaccination is free.
- No health insurance information will be collected.
- US citizenship is NOT required for the vaccine.
- Please bring a photo ID with you. It does not have to be a government issued photo ID.
- Youth under 18 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.
