Our Outreach Focus of the Month: St. Peter's Community Meal

Our Community Meal ministry has continued uninterrupted since our last sit-down dinner in March 2020, albeit as a takeout service. A small number of us prepared entrees at home until August when we were able to return to the Undercroft; bakers prepare and package individual servings of desserts; and a small distribution crew gathers to pack and hand out the meals. Leslie Hannan and Tom Newman have handled the pandemic grocery shopping and delivery for us.

We serve close to half of the guests who used to join us on the second Tuesday of each month. Certainly, health and transportation concerns explain some of the drop off, but we also suspect many of our guests came to Community Meal as much for socialization as hunger needs. The same is likely true for our volunteers - Community Meal Day was a fun few hours with friends creating something special together. Parceling out the work instead of sharing it as a group is less fulfilling perhaps.

Now that we are cooking in the Undercroft again, we have an opportunity to revive the group spirit. Virtual Parish-Wide Discernment Meeting

The Virtual Parish-Wide Discernment Meeting will be held on Sunday, November 14, 2021 following the 10 am service. The meeting will be hosted on Zoom and the meeting invitation is set forth below. Note that although the Zoom invite states the meeting will commence at 11 am, we will actually begin at 11:15 am. The problem with Zoom is that it allows to schedule only on the half hour and not the quarter hour. In any event, plan to join the meeting at 11:15 am.

The meeting will begin with some introductory remarks by our Search Consultant, David Bargetzi, who will explain how the meeting will proceed. Expect to be partnered with two other attendees and placed in a virtual breakout room. While there, you will be asked to

share some memories about something positive you have experienced at St. Peter's. One of the others in your group will be asked to be an active listener and to ask questions to explore your experience more fully. The third attendee in your group will be asked to record your thoughts by writing them down on the Recorder sheet. Everyone in your group will take a turn with each role. If time permits, we hope to convene again as a group after the breakout sessions to hear from you some of the experiences that were shared. That was a very powerful sharing time at the in-person meeting a few weeks ago and we hope to be able to hold that session virtually.

Worksheets will be emailed or mailed to participants prior to the meeting. Worksheets are also available on St. Peter's website. We ask that you print them in advance of the meeting so you have them ready when the meeting starts. After the meeting, we ask that the Recorder sheets be scanned and returned via email to Sara Ferry (sferry05325@gmail.com) and Dan Gourash (dfgourash@sseg-law.com) or sent via U.S. Mail in hard-copy to the church office. In the event you don't have the handouts at with you at the time of the meeting, we will make them available via a link in the chat room during the meeting.

To facilitate setting up the breakout rooms we ask that you **RSVP** to Leslie Hannan at the church office by Friday 11/12/2021. Let her know who will be attending and provide her with the email address of everyone who will be connecting separately to the Zoom meeting. This is a very important step to make the meeting run smoothly and without delay. Thanks in advance for your cooperation.

For those who may have attended the in-person meeting held a few weeks ago, feel free also to attend the virtual meeting. We are trying our best to reach everyone and the sense of community will be enhanced with your attendance.
