*This means if you receive communion in the center aisle your image will be shown walking to communion and receiving the sacrament. By receiving communion in the center aisle, you will be deemed to have consented to your image being shown on the Livestream.*

*If you do not want your image to be shown, you will have the option of receiving communion in the right aisle (facing the altar), which is out of the screenshot of the Livestream. Communion in the right aisle will take place after distribution of communion in the middle aisle.*

### **March Outreach Focus of the Month: Hospice of the Western Reserve**

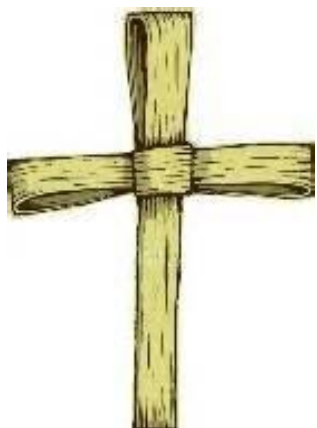
