

Join us TONIGHT for an Agape Meal 6:30 in the Chapel

The word, “agape,” is the Greek word used in the New Testament for the deepest and broadest kind of self-giving Love. The word “agape” seems to come closest to approximating the limitless and overflowing fullness of Divine Love.

An Agape Meal is an ancient tradition of table fellowship. During Jesus’ ministry and in the early Church, agape meals were a time of fellowship. The meal is a way of living out Jesus’ commandment that we love one another with the same self-emptying love, mercy and forgiveness with which he has loved and still loves us.

The meal is a simple one of bread, cheese, nuts and fruit including dried fruits like dates and figs and wine and fruit juice. Don’t worry if you are not bringing any food – just bring yourself! The Agape Meal will be followed by the Maundy Thursday service with foot washing in the church at 7:30.



Good Friday services will be held at noon and 7:30 p.m.

Please join us for the Good Friday liturgy as we mark the day of Christ's suffering, crucifixion, and death. On this most solemn of days, we fix our gaze on the cross at Golgotha. The cross serves as a sign of God’s never-failing love for us even in the midst of death.
