**November Outreach Focus of the Month:
DRINK LOCAL DRINK TAP (“DLDT”)**

Did you ever wonder who keeps the NE Ohio beaches, clean and liveable? DLDT!!

DLDT volunteers recently surpassed a half million pieces of trash picked up and disposed of from Lake Erie shores since

2010: that is 533,000 pieces of trash that did not end up in our food and water supply!

Since 2010 DLDT has hosted 127 beach clean-ups in neighborhoods and on Lake Erie Beaches in Northeast Ohio. At the conclusion of Drink Local Drink Tap’s 2022 Summer clean up season, over 1,300 volunteers had helped pick up over 2,000 pounds of trash during the 31 public clean-ups.

Given the sensitivity of aquatic ecosystems, removing trash from beaches helps maintain the natural biodiversity found in Lake Erie. This means a healthier community for us and for our children.

Clean water is a human right and volunteering is one way we can make a difference in our environment.
