January Outreach Focus: Beating Parkinsons



Rock It Out is an affiliate of Rock Steady Boxing, which is a national program of physical exercise for individuals who are living with Parkinson's disease. Though it might seem surprising, this non-contact boxing, inspired fitness routine is dramatically improving the ability of people with Parkinson's to live independent lives. Rock Steady Boxing was originally founded in Indianapolis in 2006 by former county prosecutor Scott Newman, who was diagnosed with Parkinson's at age 40. Classes are taught by Certified Personal Trainers and include exercises such as calisthenics, weight training, and non-contact boxing that attacks Parkinson's at its vulnerable neurological points. The Rock it Out affiliate has been in Lakewood for almost ten years,

and in addition to the Rock Steady boxing program, it also offers yoga and monthly seminars about topics related to Parkinson's disease. For more information, contact Maria Pujolas at:


