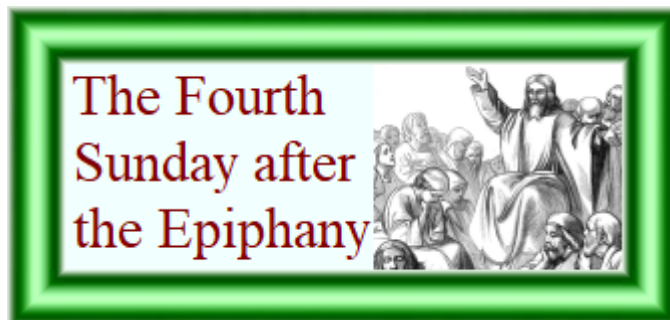

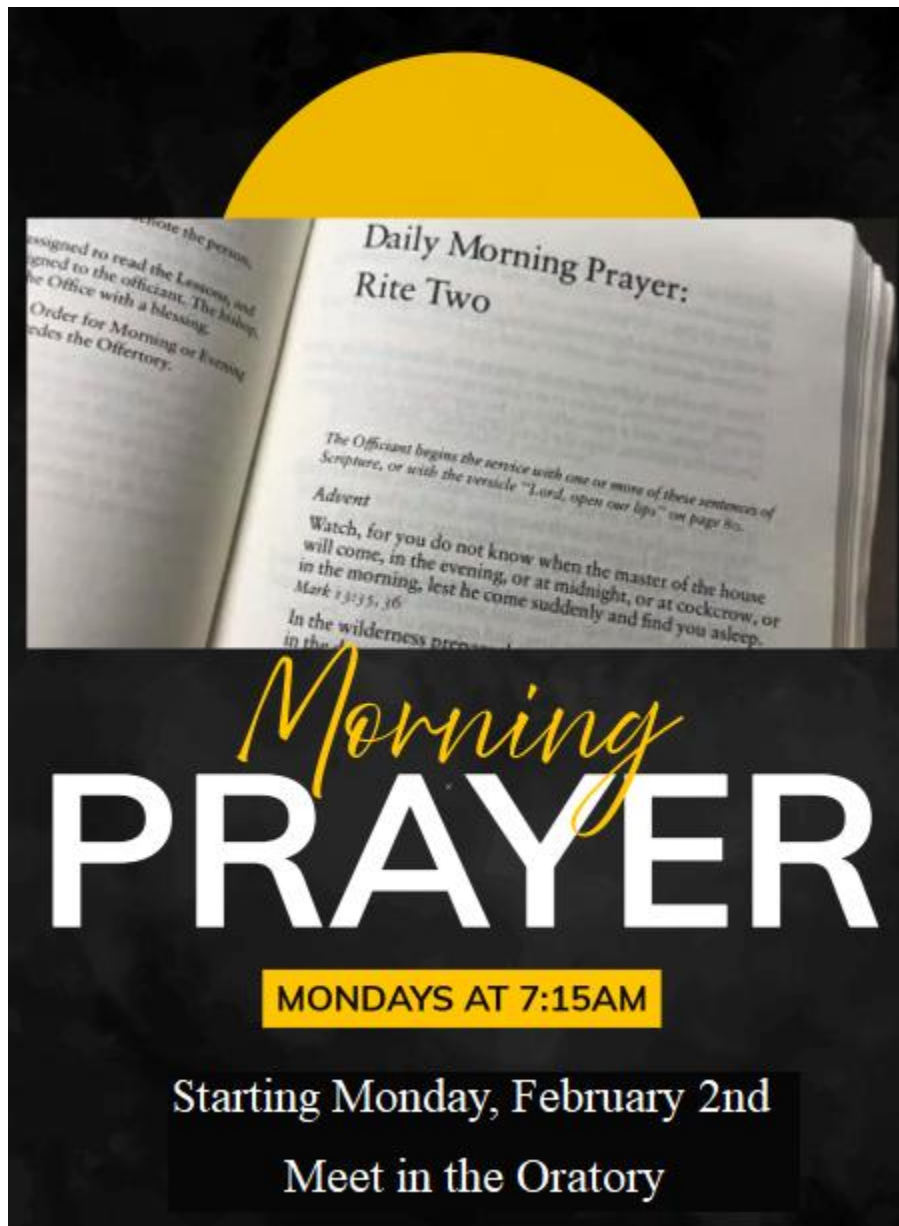

You may have heard about Cleveland Clinics "Hard 75 Challenge." It is a health/lifestyle program done over 75 days that focuses on (1) nutrition, (2) exercise, (3) reading, and (4) drinking water. Folks document their change on TikTok and Facebook to add accountability and gain support from a community. (You can Google it!)

This LENT I am inviting you into a full Body/Spirit Lenten discipline. For the 40 days of Lent, I want to challenge YOU to team with ME for a spiritual/physical twist on "Hard 75"!!! Here's how it will work. Beginning with a meeting after the NOON Ash Wednesday service & the 6:30 pm service I will go over my "Hard Lent 40" program. It will include (1) nutrition, (2) exercise, (3) spiritual reading, (4) drinking water, and (5) worship/prayer. After Sunday service, we will meet to check-in, encourage one another and learn one new thing!

Wednesday, February 18th at 6:30 p.m. – We will begin with a discussion of Lent, what is Lent, what are we supposed to do, or not do? We will literally put "Alleluia" away and then make a prayer chain to be used on Sunday mornings Throughout Lent. We will move through four more stations representing water, oil, light, and the imposition of ashes.
