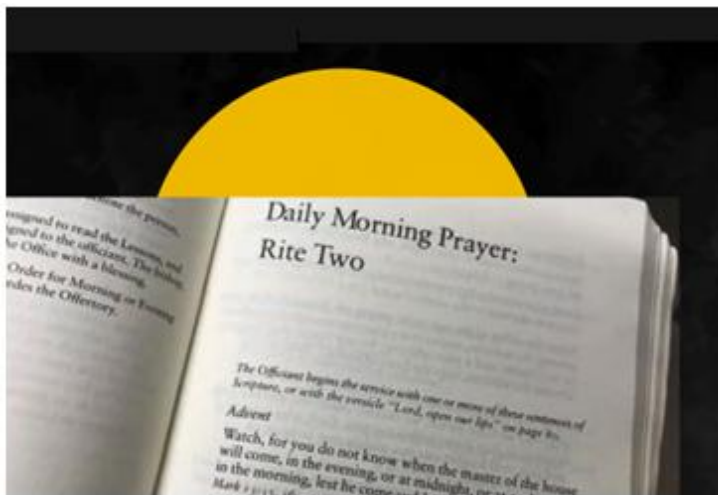

You may have heard about the 75 Hard Challenge or Cleveland Clinic's "75 Soft Challenge." It is a health/lifestyle program done over 75 days that focuses on (1) nutrition, (2) exercise, (3) reading, and (4) drinking water. Folks document their change on TikTok and Facebook to add accountability and gain support from a community. (You can Google it!)

This LENT I am inviting you into a full Body/Spirit Lenten discipline. For the 40 days of Lent, I want to challenge YOU to team with ME for a spiritual/physical twist on “Hard 75”!!! Here’s how it will work. Beginning with a meeting after the NOON Ash Wednesday service & the 6:30 pm service I will go over my “Hard Lent 40” program.
