Folks document their change on TikTok and Facebook to add accountability and gain support from a community. (You can Google it!)

This LENT I am inviting you into a full Body/Spirit Lenten discipline. For the 40 days of Lent, I want to challenge YOU to team with ME for a spiritual/physical twist on "Hard 75"!!! Here's how it will work. Beginning with a meeting after the NOON Ash Wednesday service & the 6:30 pm service I will go over my "Hard Lent 40" program. It will include (1) nutrition, (2) exercise, (3) spiritual reading, (4) drinking water, and (5) worship/prayer. After Sunday service, we will meet to check-in, encourage one another and learn one new thing! See you after service on Ash Wednesday in the NEW CHAPEL!!!!

CONFIRMATION CLASS

We will begin a Confirmation Class for those youth who turn 13 by September. We will meet Sunday's during our regularly scheduled Bible study. We will begin on Sunday, April 19th. We will meet on Sundays through June 7th. Our classes will conclude with a retreat in August, and the Bishop will perform the Sacrament of Confirmation on the first Sunday in September. We will begin with an exploration of the Sacrament and the elements therein. A sort of "Why are we here?" and "What is Confirmation?"
