FROM YOUR VESTRY: In an effort to have a more efficient and streamlined system for pledges, donations, directory information, and more, the Finance Subcommittee has been working through the transition to a new portal called Realm. The bugs and kinks are being worked now with plans to have the congregation fully integrated in Summer 2026.

There are two new subcommittees established by the Vestry - the Centennial Preservation Committee and the Bylaws Review Committee. The church will be celebrating its centennial anniversary in 2027 and a celebration we will have! The Centennial Preservation Committee is charged with gathering historic materials for St. Peter's and determining whether to purge, preserve, catalogue, and present their findings to the Vestry and congregation at large. With the volume of historic materials that are known to be in the bell tower, and through what the committee may find, this is a tall order. The Bylaws Review committee will do just as they are named - reviewing our current St. Peter's Bylaws. The last review was completed in January 2012.
