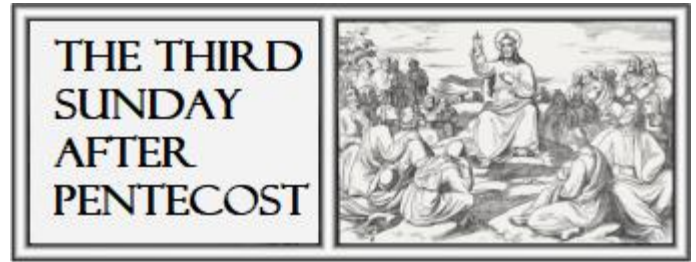

Realm is a database and communications app designed specifically for churches and their congregations. It has contribution record keeping and financial components used by Janine and Tom. It also contains the basic information about parishioners and their families. All the information about parishioners that was in Church Windows, the system we used previously, was migrated into Realm.

A unique characteristic of realm is that it is designed for parishioners to directly participate. It has communications and organizational tools. Ministry areas, groups within those areas, and subgroups. Parishioners are able to form groups, plan events, take attendance, communicate within groups, group to group, or group to the full body of the church. Everything is digitalized and available to any parishioner who receives an invitation and responds by creating an account.

Do you want a report of your giving? You can access it. Did you move or change your phone number? You can enter that information yourself. Is there something incorrect in your profile? You can correct it.

All these tools are already in the system, they just need to be utilized. That starts with everyone, or as many as possible, enrolling. PLEASE JOIN.
