Dear Pilgrim,

Thank you for considering a pilgrimage trip to England with Spirited Pilgrimages and Fr. Mike Lager. We have two itineraries planned for 2027. You are invited to select the one you feel most speaks to your spirituality and your travel needs.

This second trip is a **WALKING PILGRIMAGE ALONG ST. CUTHBERT'S WAY TO HOLY ISLAND** (also known as Lindisfarne) June 27-July 4, 2027. This is a 62 mile walk over 6 days (7 nights accommodations included) and is rated a "moderate" level hike with some steep incline points. Your baggage is transported to the next overnight accommodation while you hike with a day-pack. Because accommodations are in small pubs or inns along the path, rooms are very limited. This pilgrimage is limited to the first 12 people.

To reserve your spot, you will need to 1) fill out the reservation form provided by Spirited Travel, 2) include a copy of your Passport and your 3) deposit check made out to "Spirited Travel" and mail them USPS to the Spirited Travel address provided. The costs and registration dates for each trip is included in the informational booklet.

Below are some answers to the **FAQ's**:

- **Is my airfare included in the cost?** No. Because many want to "add" days on either side of the pilgrimage, or have travel-miles to use, each person will be responsible for booking their own flights.
- **Do I need to get travel insurance?** Highly recommended! You will want a Travel Insurance policy that includes overseas medical insurance. Review your policies to know your coverage.
- **How are the logistics of travel being handled?** Spirited Pilgrimage (www.spiritedpilgrimages.com), led by the Rev. Keith Marsh, is handling travel planning, logistics and finances. International Tours of the U.K. is the ground agent in England.
- **What is the spiritual programming for the pilgrimage?** Each day Morning Prayer will be led by Fr. Mike and will include educational insights for the places and saints we will encounter that day. Our goal is arrival and worship at Holy Island as a pilgrim group.
