Last names beginning with **A through J**, please bring **BEVERAGES**.

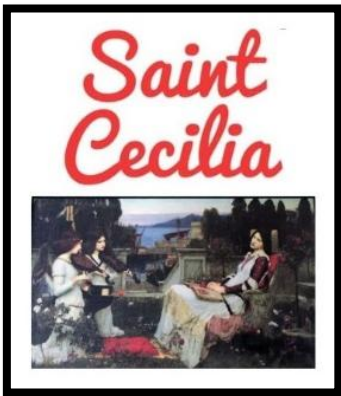
For the **K through R** names, please bring a **SIDE DISH** of your choice.
