

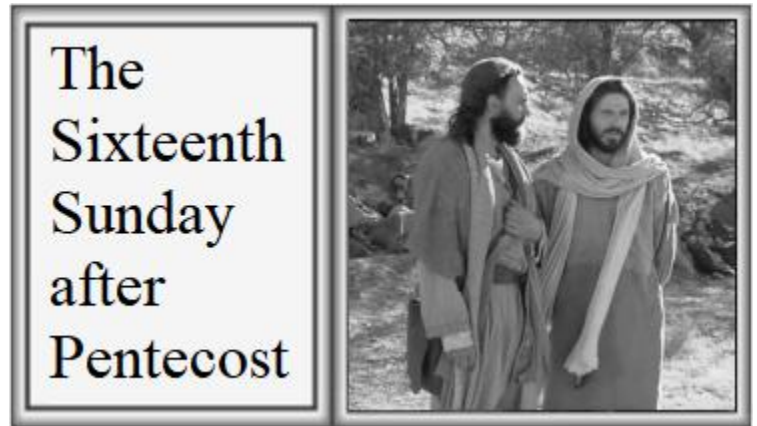

The completion of the new Reserve Care East Hospice Center marks an exciting milestone in our mission to provide compassionate, expert care to patients and families facing serious illness. Construction was completed in March, and we celebrated with a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony and Community Open House in May. Patients moved into the center in June, bringing to life a vision years in the making.
